### Lesson 9 Adjectives that Compare

3.L.1.g — High

**Adjectives** are words that describe nouns and pronouns. They can provide descriptive details or show comparisons. To compare two things, use the **comparative** form of an adjective. To compare three or more things, use the **superlative** form.

To form the comparative of one-syllable words, add -er. To form the superlative of one-syllable words, add -est. Some adjectives require spelling changes before the -er or -est is added. If the adjective is more than one syllable, the word more is usually used to form the comparative and the word *most* is used to form the superlative.

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
fast	faster	fastest
large	larger (drop the final e, add -er.)	largest (drop the final e, add -est.)
easy	easier (change y to i, add -er)	easiest (change y to i, add -est)
careful	more careful	most careful
important	more important	most important

Some adjectives change form completely.

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
good	better	best
bad	worse	worst
little	less	least

Ricardo's chili was spicier than Sonya's chili. (A comparative adjective is used to compare two things: Sonya's chili and Ricardo's chili. Since spicy ends in -y, change the y to i before adding -er.)

B. Since Dayla is being compared to every person the speaker knows, the superlative form should be used. Because thoughtful has more than one syllable, the superlative is formed by adding most.

- **5.** C. The comparative *more popular* is correct because the sentence compares two things, the bands Zoe likes and the band I like. *Popular* is more than one syllable, so the comparative is formed by using *more*.
- 6. A. Passing the skills test enables LeBron to use the *most dangerous* machines of any in the company, so the superlative form is correct. *Dangerous* is more than one syllable, so the superlative is formed by using *most*.
- 7. B. The speaker compares the cave to all the other places he or she had been, and so the superlative darkest is correct.
- **8.** D. The sentence compares two fruits, peaches and apples, so the comparative form *fresher* is correct.

- C. The sentence compares two different times, today and yesterday, so the comparative colder is correct.
- **10.** A. The superlative *tallest* is used because the sentence compares Priya to all of the members of her team.
- **11.** B. More than two people walked together in the field, so the superlative *least muddy* is needed.
- **12.** C. The comparative form *farther* is correct because Azad is comparing two cities.
- D. The mango juice is compared to many other beverages offered, so the superlative sweetest is correct.
- 14. B. The superlative most accomplished is used here because the sentence compares Kanda to many other musicians. Accomplished is more than one syllable, so the superlative is formed by using most.
